## EXPLANATION ON THE COMBINAISON OF CLASSES

## Art. 6.1.007

Since $1^{\text {st }}$ January 2014 classes can be combined, even if more than 5 riders per category are registered.

This can only be done on the following conditions:

- The organiser announces in the technical guide and in their communication towards National Federations and riders the combination of classes.
- The results are split into two separate classes based on the results summary.
- Riders get the ranking points that correspond with the place in the separate results.
- The riders are awarded the prize money that corresponds with the place in the separate Results.

Except as provided by the combination rules, no rider is permitted to compete outside of his age or gender group during UCl registered races.

- Different combinations are possible :

Challenge - Challenge
Championships - Challenge
Championships - Championships
Championships - Masters
Challenge - Masters

- Combination of categories with different genders are possible:

For example: Women Junior with Challenge boys 16

- If a combination of classes is done, all riders of that category need to be combined. It's impossible to combine just a part of a category with another category.

For example: 5 Men Juniors race with Men Elite while the other Men Juniors do their own competition.

- More than 2 categories can be combined:

For example: Challenge women 17 and over - Women Juniors - Women Elite

## Final classification

The final classification (results summary) of the competition is determined by:

1. The phase reached (Final, $1 / 2$ final, $1 / 4$ final, $1 / 8$ final, $1 / 16$ final, $1 / 32$ final, motos)
2. The rank from this phase
3. The total points from this phase
4. The time in the last run, in case of ties the time from the previous run is considered

When the tie cannot be broken by time, the riders will share the same rank.
In case of a combination of classes, this results summary will be used to split the results of two classes and to make a separate result per category.
