

2016 BMX Competition Guide & Rules

2016 UEC BMX EUROPEAN CUP

Rounds 1 & 2: Zolder (BEL), 01-03 April

Rounds 3 & 4: Kempen (NED), 29-30 April / 01 May

Rounds 5 & 6: Weiterstadt (GER), 10-12 June

Rounds 7 & 8: Calais (FRA), 16-18 September

1. 2016 UEC BMX EUROPEAN CUP TEAM RANKING

The 2016 UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will consist on 8 rounds. All races count.

All teams have to register through UEC prior to the first event of the season in order to take part to the 2016 UEC BMX European Cup Teams Ranking.

Those teams will receive from the UEC:

- one specific UEC pass for the whole 2016
- and 2 entrance bracelets for each team per event (5 events).

Only team who are duly registered to an event of the European Cup can receive these 2 bracelets. The entrance bracelets will allow them to have free entrance and an access to the surroundings of the track.

Only the UEC pass will allow the access to the Team Manager Area.

These passes and bracelets won't be accepted in Verona (ITA) for the CC race.

The overall award ceremony will be held in Calais (FRA), on the Sunday, September 18th with Team coaches and maximum 4 riders.





The UEC Commission will award 3 trophies to the 3 first teams and one medal to each rider of the team:

- o Gold medal for the 1st team of the 2016 UEC BMX European Cup Team ranking
- o Silver medal for the 2nd team of the 2016 UEC BMX European Cup Team ranking
- o Bronze medal for the 3rd team of the 2016 UEC BMX European Cup Team ranking

Rules:

- all teams have to register and pay a registration fee to the UEC at the beginning of the season (deadline March 1st 2016) – UEC fee € 200,00.
- teams have to confirm their participation to the event (2016 UEC BMX European Cup) together with riders' registration on Friday from 11.00 to 16.00.
- o teams have to pay a fee to the organizers of € 150,00.
- there will be no team ranking or team area on the Continental Championship race but UEC registered teams can still hire a team space : € 150,00 has to be paid to the organizers.

As a counterpart the organizers will:

- provide spaces, as close as possible to the track, of 6 x 3 m for each team registered for that specific race;
- promote the name of the Team during races.

Riders:

- o all classes are welcome: challenge (20 & 24') and championship
- o 10 riders maximum in a team, but points will be given only to 4 riders registered by the Team Coach.
- the list of registered riders will be sent out to all teams after registration deadline, two weeks before the event, and they will have one week to decide which riders will make points, with possibility to change at registration control
- o points will be given according to European official grid

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
