On June 4th Championships categories: first 3 riders will receive prize money(according overall Baltic Sea Cup rules). Prizes depends from championships riders registration fees, plus 100.-EUR for WJ/WE and 200.-EUR for MJ/ME from organizing committee.

1st place 50 %; 2nd place 30%; 3rd place 20%

Points for overall Baltic Sea Cup will distributed as follows: 1st place – 12 ; 2nd -9; 3rd -7; 4th -6; 5th -5; 6th- 4; 7th- 3; 8th – 1.

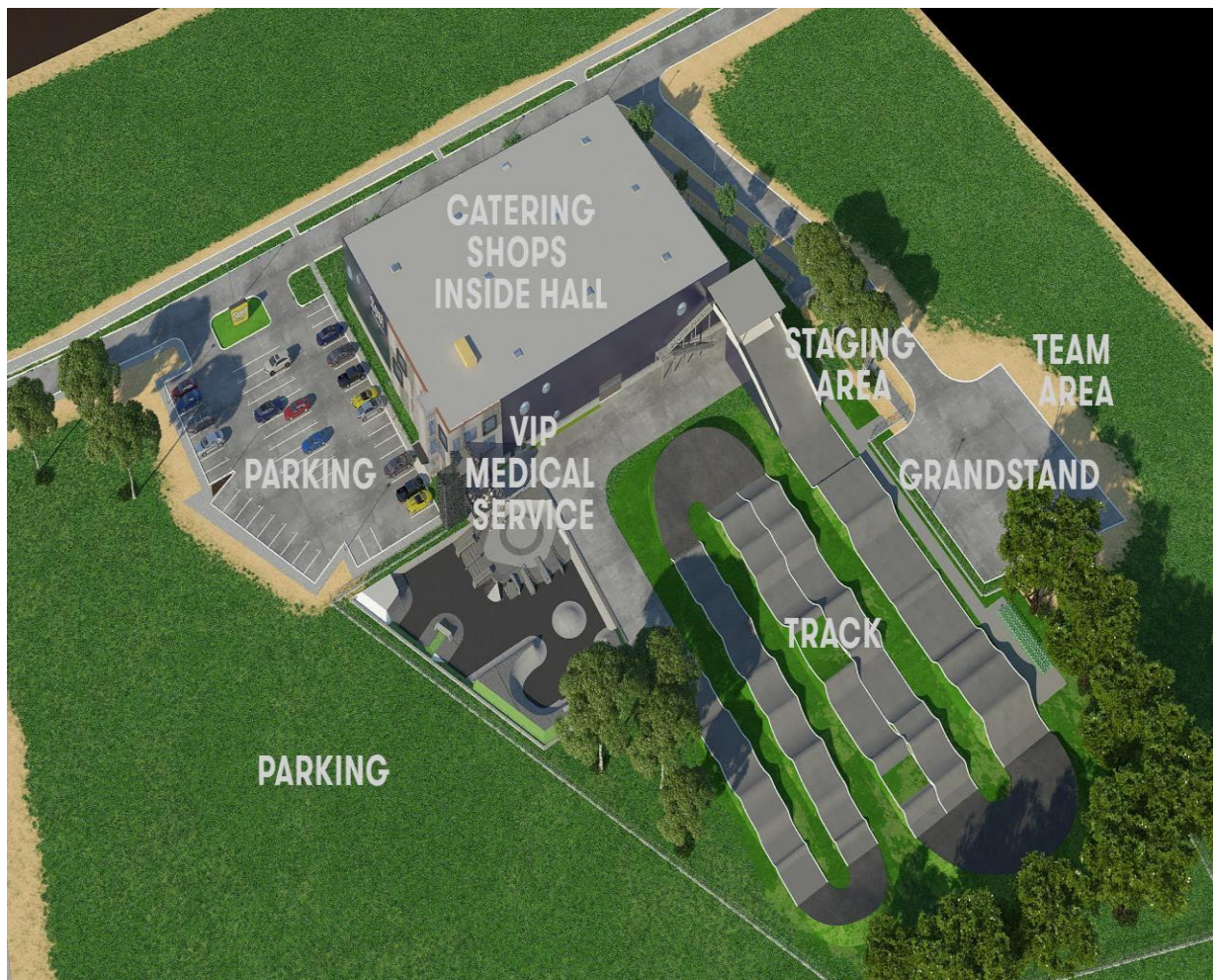

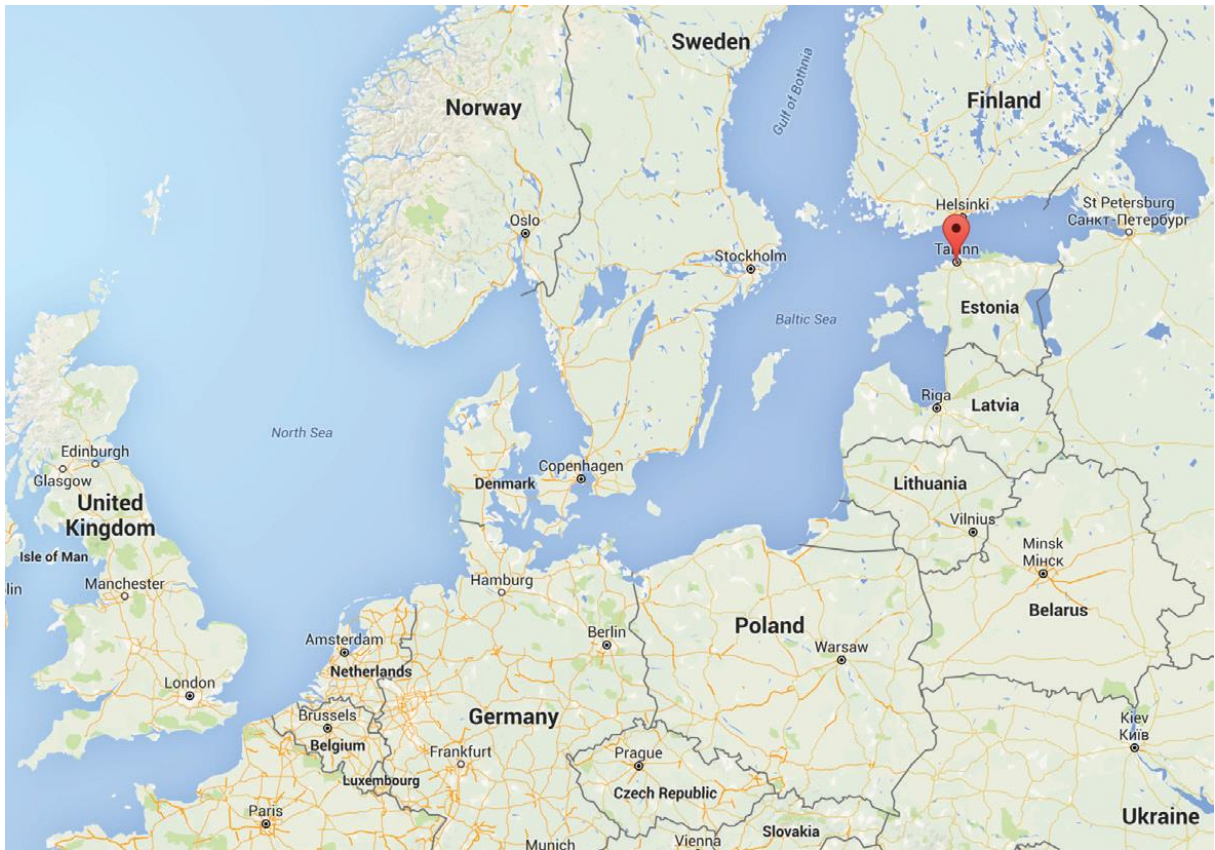

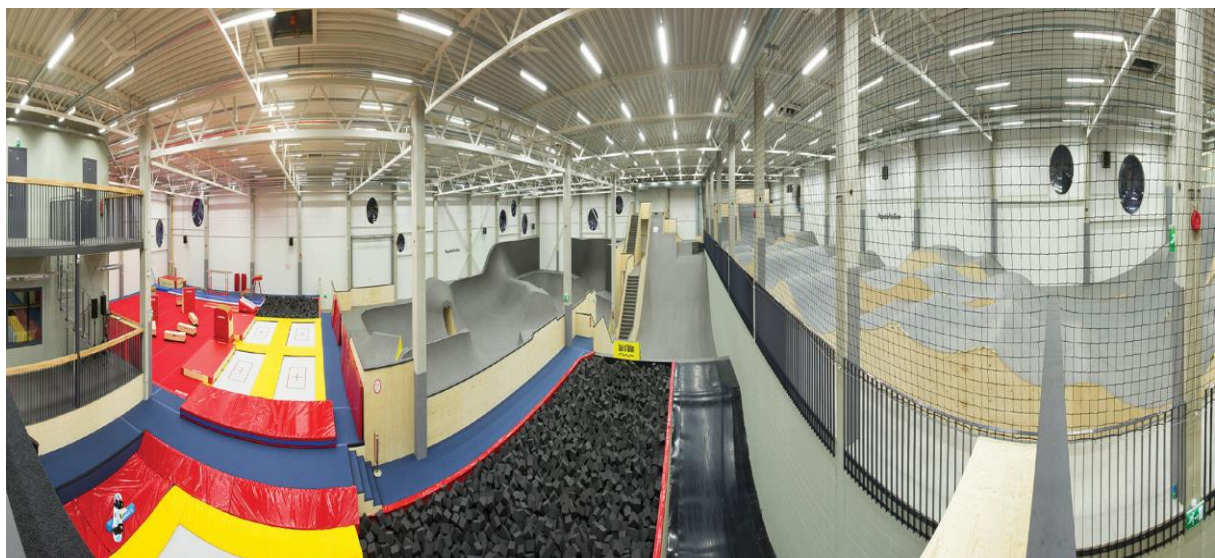
