2012 Olympic Games qualification system – Tripartite commission places BMX

Dear Sir, Madam,

As you are aware, there are two “Tripartite Commission Places” in the qualification quota for the 2012 Olympic Games for BMX. One (1) for Men Elite and one (1) for Women Elite. No applications were received from eligible NOCs for BMX.

As such, we would like to confirm that these two (2) places available will be redistributed according to the principles defined in the qualification system:

Men: places will be awarded to the next best ranked NOC(s) according to the UCI ranking by nation of the 2012 UCI BMX World Championships, which have not yet qualified.

Women: places will be awarded to the next best ranked NOC(s) according to the UCI ranking by nation of the 2012 UCI BMX World Championships, which have not yet qualified.
